Attendance Matters!

Not feeling well?

- Always use the KJMS <u>attendance form</u> or call the school Planned absence?
- Use the attendance form, send a note, or call ahead. The form works best as the phone lines can get busy!
- Absences of 3+ days should be submitted at least a week in advance

-Always bring a photo ID for check out -Students can only be released to people 18 or older who are listed on emergency care card - be sure to update!

Chronic absenteeism is a primary cause of lower academic achievement even when the absences are "excused" or understandable.

Students who attend 90% or more of the school year are more likely to graduate from high school on time.



- ★ Rolling Gradebook; Retake policy kids will need help recognizing when to retake and when to move on.






