Chorus in middle school is a great way to meet new friends and create memories that will last a lifetime. Chorus is a year-long elective. We have tons of fun playing games, building relationships, and of course making music! Even if you've never been involved in a formal choral ensemble before, now is the time to join!

## What classes are offered in the Choral Department?

Treble Chorus/Basso Chorus: These two choirs are great for students who love to sing but aren't ready for the pressure of our advanced ensembles. We have a lot of fun, learn fundamental choral skills, and NO PLACEMENT HEARING is required!

Advanced Basso Chorus: We hope to be able to offer this course next year! It will be an ensemble for more advanced tenor and bass voices to continue to grow and sing together. Placement hearing or teacher recommendation required.

Vocal Ensemble: This auditioned choir is made up of talented $7^{\text {th }}$ and $8^{\text {th }}$ grade treble voices. If you love to sing and want a good challenge, this choir is for you! Placement hearing or teacher recommendation required.

## What classes are offered in the Choral Department?

Bella Canzone: This fantastic ensemble features the best treble of the KJMS community. This choir is made up of advanced $8^{\text {th }}$ graders. It is a choir for the most dedicated choral singers who will perform in a variety of performances throughout the year. Challenging repertoire will take this choir soaring to new heights! Placement hearing or teacher recommendation is required.

Music Participation Lab (MPL)- Music Participation Lab is a semester course and not a formal chorus class. Students will broaden their knowledge of music through learning keyboard skills, music notation, composition, music history and studying composers and musicians both past and present. This class is for anyone who loves music and wants to explore it further!

- String Ensemble (intermediate level 1)
- Concert Orchestra (intermediate level 2)
- Symphonic Orchestra (advanced level 1)
- Chamber Orchestra (advanced level 2)

Orchestra is a class that is the same amount of time as your other classes.

If you play cello or bass, you will be provided an instrument to keep at school, so you do not have to haul your instrument back and forth 3 times a week.

If you make Orchestra your $1^{\text {st }}$ or $2^{\text {nd }}$ choice on your course selection form, you will be placed in an orchestra in the spring based on an audition or a teacher
